

## **Stampede Shootout**

### **Central Check-In Directions**

Teams playing in the Tournament are required to appear at Central Check-In to have their rosters verified. Here are the specifics:

1) Central Check-In will be at **the Oak Hall School student center**, about 50 yards east of the gym. Check in times:

**Friday from 500 pm – 1000 pm**

**Saturday from 900 am - 1200 pm**

**2) Teams that have had their entire rosters approved at an earlier USSSA tournament do not need to appear at Central Check In. If you have already played in a USSSA tournament in 2008, only a coach or team representative needs to come to Central Check In.**

3) You do not have to check in before your first game, but you **MUST** check in before you play your second game.

4) If this is your first USSSA tournament in 2008 you must bring all your players who will be playing this weekend to Central Check In. If all your players are not available at the time you check in, any missing players who will play on Saturday or Sunday must come to Oak Hall School with the appropriate materials before they are eligible to play in the tournament.

3) The materials you must have in your team book for Central Check In include:

- a) Roster with signatures for each player
- b) Birth certificates for each player
- c) Report cards for each player
- d) Photos for each player

4) Once you have been checked in you will be given a roster to take with you to each of your games. You will give the roster to the scorekeeper before each game and that will be the list of players eligible to play in the game. Be sure to get the roster back after each game so you have it for your next game.

7) All coaches **MUST** be members of ACA. If you do not have your ACA card you **Must** pick up a temporary pass at check in. If you are not on the list of pending applicants you must fill out an application and pay membership fees before receiving a temporary pass.

You **MUST** have your ACA card or a temporary pass if you want to sit on the bench for any games during the tournament.

**REMEMBER: Every team must have a coach or team representative come to Oak Hall School to check in their teams. If you fail to check in before your second game you will not be allowed to play your second game or any others until you complete the check in process.**
